

What is Gift Aid?

A Government scheme that lets charities claim tax relief on the donations that UK tax payers make to them.

How does Gift Aid work for charity shop donations?

The shop sells items on behalf of the donor who then donates the proceeds to the charity.

How much money is raised on Gift Aided items?

For every £1 raised from donated goods sales, charities can claim an extra 25p from the Government via Gift Aid.

Who is eligible to Gift Aid their charity shop donations?

Any UK taxpayer who pays Income Tax or Capital Gains Tax.

Why is Gift Aid important?

Gift Aid is a source of income for so many good causes, helping to carry out vital services.
